

- What do Europeans think? On 25 January, the Commission published a special Europarometer survey on the future of Europe.
- Linking the levels of democracies: On 27 January, the CoR adopted a new Resolution on CoFE suggesting a more important role for citizens, regions and cities in EU policy-making". Link.
- European Citizens' Panel in Maastricht: Between 11 and 13 February, the third and final meeting of the European Citizens' Panel 4 debating on the "EU in the world" and "migration" will be held in the European Institute for Public Administration in Maastricht. Link.
- European Citizens' Panel in Dublin: Between 25 and 27 February, the European Citizens' Panel 1 debating on a "stronger economy, social justice, jobs", "education, youth, culture, sport", and "digital transformation" will hold its third and final meeting in the Institute of International and European Affairs in Dublin.
